The IFLA Environment, Sustainability and Libraries Section updated definition of a "green library". The concept of "green library" was first introduced in the 1990s. Since then, libraries have been undertaking various initiatives to reduce their negative human impact on the natural environment, and the concept of a sustainable library working toward this aim.

In this new definition from ENSULIB, a green library is a library, which is a library taking into account environmental, social and sustainable libraries may be of any size, but its agenda, which includes green buildings and equipment, economy, sustainable library services, social sustainability, commitment to general environmental goals and program development. This definition is translated into 10 languages at present, and more to come.

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What is a Green Library?

Definition from the IFLA ENSULIB Section

Environment means the surroundings or conditions in which animals, or plants live and operate. Environment:

Sustainable development is development that "meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs" (Brundtland Report, UN).

Present environments are endangered by climate change, inequalities. All organizations should strive to protect the environment. This includes all kinds of libraries, and sustainable development.

Yeşil ve sürdürülebilir bir kütüphane, çevresel, ekonomik ve sosyal sürdürülebilirliği dikkate alan bir kütüphanedir. Yeşil ve sürdürülebilir kütüphaneler herhangi bir boyutta olabilir, ancak aşağıdakileri içeren net bir sürdürülebilirlik gündemine sahip olmalıdırlar:

- Yeşil binalar ve ekipman:** Bina ve ekipmanın emisyonları veya karbon ayak izi aktif olarak azaltılır.
- Yeşil ofis ilkeleri:** Operasyonel rutinler ve süreçler çevresel açıdan sürdürülebilirdir.
- Sürdürülebilir ekonomi:** Tüketim kısıtları, döngüsel ve paylaşım ekonomisi uygulamaları geliştirilir ve toplum tarafından erişilebilir hale getirilir.
- Sürdürülebilir kütüphane hizmetleri:** Kullanıcılar için ilgili ve güncel bilgilere erişimi kolay, ortak alanlar, cihazlar ve çevre eğitimi sunuluyor ve operasyonlar verimlidir. Kütüphanede pozitif bir karbon el izi var.
- Sosyal sürdürülebilirlik:** İyi eğitim, okuryazarlık, topluluk katılımı, kültürler arası çeşitlilik, sosyal içermeye ve genel katılım dikkate alınır. Kütüphane, eşitsizliği azaltmak için aktif olarak çalışır.
- Çevre yönetimi:** Çevresel hedefler SMART'tır (Spesifik, Ölçülebilir, Ulaşılabilir, Gerçekçi ve Zamana Bağlı) ve kütüphane çevre üzerindeki kendi olumsuz etkisini azaltmak için çalışır. Kütüphanenin çevre politikası, uygulaması ve çevre çalışmalarının sonuçları daha geniş bir kitleye iletilir.
- Genel çevresel hedeflere ve programlara bağlılık:** Bağlılık, BM Sürdürülebilir Kalkınma Hedefleri, Paris İklim Anlaşması ve ilgili çevre sertifikaları ve programları tarafından yönlendirilir.

TUNISIAN LIBRARY'S DIGITAL SKILLS COURSE PROMOTES OPPORTUNITIES FOR WOMEN

Tunisia faces not only a relatively high illiteracy rate of 19.1%, but also a large number of early school leavers – up to 120 000 in 2014 according to the National Institute of Statistics (2014). Connected to this is a high unemployment rate, standing at 22.79% and 12.55% for women and men respectively. Much of the problem of early school leaving is concentrated in rural areas of the country.

One such area is the island of Djerba in southern Tunisia. The Erriadh district, in the middle of the island, is home to 10 626 inhabitants according to 2014 census figures. While there are a number of small factories and shops, it faces similar challenges to other parts of the country, but is rich in civil institutions including a library and other cultural, educational and social organisations which work together for the benefit of all.

Given its commitment to sustainable development, the Erriadh Public Library has therefore sought to help primarily illiterate women develop digital skills by launching a computer literacy club.

This initiative aimed to give those who had left school without skills a second chance to build their ability to find work by giving them the knowledge and support to become computer literate. The course placed a particular emphasis on inclusive life-long learning, gender equality, and access to decent jobs and economic development.
