

### NATO member countries

Twenty-eight member countries, promoting security and stability through diplomatic, political and military means. They are committed to the principles of collective defense, which means that an attack against one member or its territory would be an attack against all.

NATO also develops partnerships with non-NATO countries involved in alliance management operations and relations.

### Euro-Atlantic Partners


Partnership with non-NATO countries started in early 1990s. To help others in their development, build trust & democratic institutions, maintain political stability and prevent international terrorism. Euro-Atlantic Partnership Council and Euro-Atlantic Integration Council are the main bodies of the Euro-Atlantic Partnership Council and practical cooperation is organized with individual partner countries through NATO Partnership for Peace programs. NATO also has strategic political relationships with Russia, Ukraine and Georgia.



### Partners across the globe

NATO has conducted bilateral dialogues with a number of countries which are not part of NATO or other partnership frameworks. They include several small Asian states, Japan, the Republic of Korea, New Zealand, Poland, Tonga, Afghanistan and Mongolia. They develop cooperation with NATO in areas of mutual interest and areas available directly to NATO operations or militarily or in another other way.
